- Theory tasks- this is a Certificate III level course. and while the
 content is not too difficult there is an expectation for you to
 commit to the theory requirements which teach you how to work
 in areas of the event industry and how to work with other
 people. A 'C' grade in Year 10 English is required to enter this
 Certificate course.


The Certificate III in Events provides students with a range of skills and knowledge to contribute to events in the school and the local and wider communities.



CERTIFICATE III EVENTS WHAT DOES IT PREPARE YOU FOR?:

Events coordination, marketing management, stylists, hospitalities, tour guides, graphic design, exhibitors, building and construction, lighting and audio design, set designers, entertainers and artists, key-note and motivational speakers, merchandise retail and hire, travel and tour guides, security, technologies – creation and management of online events platforms, health and safety roles....

The list goes on and on and on!!!



CERTIFICATE II VISUAL ART WHAT WILL YOU DO?

- A range of Units including 12 units, 4 core units and 8 elective units.
- All units must be completed to achieve the full certificate. This
 is a 2-year course, the 12 units
- As part of the Certificate II in Visual Art you will work towards exhibiting your work at our Creating Identity Exhibition – offering members of the community a change to buy your ART!
- Theory tasks- this is a Certificate II level course and while the content is not too difficult there is an expectation for you to commit to the theory requirements. A 'C' grade for English is a prerequisite for the Certificate II courses.



WHY STUDY CERTIFICATE II VISUAL ARTS?

- During four periods of dance a week, we will nurture your creativity by delving deeper into multiple dance styles and choreographic challenges.

YEAR 11 DRAMA ATAR AND DRAMA GENERAL

- Create, interpret and perform original drama and plays written or devised by others.
- Complete design and production roles such as sets, costume, makeup, props, sound and lighting.
- Present drama to a range of audiences.
- Study set texts in detail offering insights into these plays as they perform and respond.
- Study Drama practitioners understanding the development of different dramatic styles and approaches.
- Reflective and analytical processes used to make informed judgements when responding to drama

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE DRAMA COURSES

While both courses are 'pitched' at a high level of experience, knowledge and understanding the GENERAL course puts more weighting on the practical component of the course (70%)

You WILL NOT sit exams if you study GENERAL DRAMA.

You WILL SIT practical and written examinations as a Year 11 Drama ATAR student.

To enrol in Drama ATAR you MUST be recommended for ATAR English/Literature AND have received a 'B' OR above grade for Year 10 Drama.

YEAR 11 MUSIC ATAR



The Music ATAR course encourages students to:

Explore a range of musical experiences AND

Developing their musical skills and understanding, and creative and expressive potential.

The course consists of a written component, a composition portfolio and a practical component.

For the practical component students can choose to perform an instrument or study voice or submit a separate composition portfolio.

At MRSHS the Music course also provides opportunities for creative expression, through several performance opportunities throughout the year.

Studying music may also provide a pathway for further training and employment in a range of professions within the music industry. Lots of our past Music students have successfully auditioned for WAAPA!!

TO DO MUSIC ATAR:

In order to study Music ATAR you will have to:

• A 'B' grade of above in Year 10 Music is a prerequisite for this course.
