BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE (BYOD)

"Bring your own device" (BYOD) refers to a technology model that allows students to bring their own devices to school for learning in the classroom. At Margaret River SHS we ask students to bring a device to school as a tool for learning. As this device will be in the hand of your child, we make a few recommendations to ensure your choice will last and be fit for purpose.

Purchasing a device - Minimum Specifications

The following specifications guidelines ensure the device can be supported within the Margaret River SHS network. A Windows or Mac laptop integrates more effectively into our ICT workflow. Devices should comply with the minimum specs listed below:

- A screen size of 13" to 14" (note- larger than this may be difficult to carry around)
- SSD (Solid State Drive) 256GB or 512GB
- 16GB RAM
- Operating system: Windows 11 or Mac OSX 10.15 or later
- Battery life of 5+ hours
- Physical keyboard & mouse/touch pad
- Robust: they will possibly use the same device for 3+ years.
- Invest in extended warranty and insurance, accidents happen, and repairs cost a lot more and take longer without it
- We recommend a touchscreen and stylus pen this allows students to write digital notes, keep up their hand-writing skills and embed learning with active participation.

We do not recommend a Chromebook, iPad or Android tablet.

While these devices will be able to access the internet they are not compatible with school software, NAPLAN and printing.
